Luncheon Meeting Minutes, April 15, 2010

Len Dillinger asked everyone to send announcements, accomplishments and awards for the newsletter and website. An announcement was made about the next Young Members social and a flyer was handed out to be posted on company bulletin boards. The next meeting will be on May 13th.

Nicole Randazzo informed the group that the Post received 18 scholarship applications which is double what we had last year. The decision would be made today for the recipients.

The slate for the 2010/2011 board was passed out. The slate passed unanimously. The board will be installed next month.

Jason Shiflet from Zapata Engineering presented "Site and Source Delineation of Co-Mingled Trichloroethene (TCE) Plume at Tinker AFB, Oklahoma City, OK". The purpose of the project was to determine the amount of contamination in the ground water on the Tinker AFB. The IWTP and repair depot on the site had been in operation starting in 1942. This area was considered a Superfund site. Zapata monitored over 100 wells to determine the ground water flow and the extent of contamination. It was determined that TCE, DCE and PCE were present in the different aquifers. The migration of the contaminants was shown with 3D GIS models.
